Helplanka handovers 12 Houses

Helplanka will be handing over the keys to 12 newly constructed houses for homeless families in Ahangama (South of Galle, Sri Lanka). The ceremony to mark the occasion will take place on Sunday 22 July 2007 at Ahankanda, Ahangama and sees the culmination of 2 years of fundraising and organising including donors from the UK, Sri Lanka and Switzerland.

12 hampers of dry rations will also be donated to the families who suffered great loss due to the Tsunami. Helplanka is also planning to help the local schools where children of the new residents attend.
